

2010 Could Be Record Year !!

Entries for the 2010 Iowa Senior Olympics are coming in at a record pace. Over 600 individuals are registered to compete in the 68 events. With two weeks remaining for the main competition June 17 – 20 it looks like a great year. Last year had 623 people competing for medals and the all time record is 683 from 2006. 19 states are already represented in the entries from as far away as California and Florida. Kansas and Nebraska have the most representation with 36 and 30 respectively.

If you are already signed up, it will be a lot of fun. Get a friend to join you and it will be even more memorable. If you haven't signed up yet, there is still time.
